



Boil Water Notice Rescinded

Affected areas is as follows: FM 2520 to FM 1421, (east to west)
and Exp 77 to Rice Tract Rd (north and south)

January 24, 2024

On January 19, 2024, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the Military Highway Water Supply Corporation, public water system, TX1080067, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of January 24, 2024.
